BEYOND BULLYING - BUILDING SAFE SCHOOLS

Of the nearly two million students attending 4700 schools in Ontario, approximately one in three students in Grades 7-12 reports having been bullied at school, and just under one third report having bullied someone else (Centre for Addiction and Mental Health, 2004).

This interactive 3 hour workshop will explore the issues around student bullying: how to identify bullying, the types of bullying, the consequences of bullying and strategies for preventing and dealing with bullying behaviour. Upon completion of the workshop, each participant will receive a certificate of achievement.

CYBERBULLYING

Cyberbullying is a recent phenomenon with the growing popularity of websites such as Facebook, YouTube, and RateMyTeacher and the popularity of new technologies such as Ipods, cell phones, digital cameras, MP3 players and other electronic devices that can clandestinely capture pictures, videos, and sound files and have them quickly uploaded to the Internet.
